Electronic tolling and overview

All toll roads in Australia now offer the convenience of paying for your tolls electronically, without stopping at a cash booth. Some, like Lane Cove Tunnel, Military Road E-Ramp and Westlink M7, are fully electronic toll roads without any cash booths so to use these roads you need to make arrangements to pay using electronic tolling.

Paying with an e-TAG

The simplest way to pay for tolls is with an electronic tag. That's because all electronic tags work on all toll roads.

You don't come to Smith Street to be the same as everyone else, you come to Smith Street to stand out.


- ... the first Coles store was opened in Smith Street in 1914.
- ... a tunnel was used to communicate between the Foy & Gibson department store on Smith Street and their warehouses located between Little Oxford Street and Wellington Street.





